"What Home Means to Me" 2024 Poster Contest: Entry Rules

ENTRY DEADLINE: MARCH 14, 2024

Poster Rules:

- Theme: "What Home Means to Me"
- Size: All posters must be 28" x 22" and must be horizontally oriented (landscape) to be considered for national judging. National winners will be featured in a 2025 "What Home Means to Me" calendar.
- Media: Contestant may use any art media (marker, crayon, paint, collage, textiles, etc.), but please consider that posters will need to be packaged, mailed and reproduced.
- Contestants must sign an application form making their entry the property of the National Association of Housing & Redevelopment Officials (NAHRO) and permitting duplication and publication of their poster.
- · Contestants must complete a NAHRO photo release form giving NAHRO permission to use their picture for online and print publication.
- Contestants must complete a narrative form that includes a short written paragraph about what inspired their poster design—what is your poster about and why are the pictures it contains important to you?

- The application form, narrative form and photo release form should be secured to the back of the entry.

Eligibility and Selection Categories:

The "What Home Means to Me" poster contest is open to children in grades K-12 residing in affordable housing assisted directly or supported under community development, as well as children in grades K-12 whose family participates in an affordable housing program administered by a NAHRO member authority. The GRHC's local competition is open exclusively to residents of GRHC housing programs.

Poster entry must be created by only one person. Entries created by two or more people will not be accepted.

Age Categories:

Elementary - Kindergarten (K) to 5th grade

Middle - 6th to 8th grade

High - 9th to 12th grade

GRHC, State and Regional Council Competitions

The GRHC will evaluate entries submitted by our residents and will award one \$25 gift card in each contest age category. All entries submitted to the GRHC will be sent on to the Michigan Chapter of NAHRO for judging at the state level. State winners will be sent on to a regional competition and three regional winners (one from each age category) will be sent to the national NAHRO competition in Washington, DC.

National Competition

Thirteen national contest winners will be selected by a panel of judges to be assembled by National NAHRO staff. National winners will be officially announced during "Housing America Month" in October. Winners will be selected based on how well the artwork uses the "What Home Means to Me" theme. All eight NAHRO regions will be represented in a 2024 "What Home Means to Me" calendar that features the winners' poster art.

National prizes: Twelve national winners will each receive a \$100 Visa gift card. The national Grand Prize winner will be awarded an iPad and a framed copy of their original artwork. The Grand Prize winner and one family member will also be provided with transportation to and from and lodging at NAHRO's Washington Conference in Washington, DC.
