2025-2030 FIVE-YEAR-PLAN, 2025 ANNUAL AGENCY PLAN
AND 2025 MOVING TO WORK SUPPLEMENT

The Grand Rapids Housing Commission (GRHC) has developed its 2025-2030 Five-Year Plan and 2025 Annual Agency Plan in compliance with the Quality Housing & Work Responsibility Act of 1998. The GRHC has developed its 2025 Moving to Work (MTW) Supplement to the Annual Agency Plan in compliance with applicable HUD regulations. Moving to Work is a demonstration program that allows housing authorities to design and test innovative strategies for providing low-income families with affordable housing and paths to economic independence.
